Hotel Lucia on the West side is luxurious, stylish and perfectly situated. The beds are incredibly comfy and a pillow menu is provided, should you feel the need to mix it up. Room service is by Typhoon, some of the best Thai food around. The staff is on it and hip enough to provide the dish on good shows during your stay, plus Dante's, Mary's Strip Club, and VooDoo Doughnuts are all within walking distance. Rooms are around \$150 (and well worth it).

The Jupiter Hotel has the mojo of east. An updated 1950s motor inn, the rooms are artfully modern, with wifi and a masseuse on call. Downstairs hosts the Ivy Studio (modern market), Wack salon and the Q& modeling agency. Perhaps the most attractive feature is the adjoining venue Doug Fir which exudes rock ambience with unforgettable décor and cozy fireplaces to boot. Order up a Pearl Necklace (vodka, Godiva white chocolate liqueur, Frangelico & cream), then head downstairs and enjoy the show. Rooms run between \$89-\$129.

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
