**Tu Tu' Tun Lodge, Gold Beach**

Every room's private patio or balcony offers views of the Rogue River at this "luxurious but rustic forest retreat." In rooms, guests find details like steam showers and binoculars for watching wildlife, along with a "very comfy bed and cozy fireplace." Staff are "friendly and helpful in a casual way." Meals are communal; four-course dinners include organic vegetables. \$\$\$; 18 rooms; pool, water sports; 541-247-6664; [tutun.com](http://tutun.com).

**Hotel deLuxe, Portland**

**Rittenhouse Hotel, Philadelphia**

This "low-key Southern home-style inn" sits between a tidal estuary and a forest. "Not overly luxurious cottages" are designed with vaulted ceilings, full kitchens, and verandas—perfect for "enjoying some quiet time." River House Restaurant focuses on seafood; "blissful spa treatments" use local ingredients such as cornmeal and mulberry leaves. **Charleston Place, Charleston**

Reminiscent of a grand seventeenth-century residence, this eight-story hotel has an Italian marble lobby with a Georgian open-arm staircase. "Old South-style rooms" have period fabrics, stenciled wood-floor foyers, and bathrooms with brass fixtures. In the afternoon, some guests don hats and gloves for the English-style tea at the Thoroughbred Club. Try the 24-karat-gold facial at the European-style spa.

**French Quarter Inn, Charleston**

The six-year-old inn one block from St. Philip's Steeple is "a good base for exploring the town." At check-in, guests receive champagne, and each evening look forward to "milk and cookies—a very nice touch." Eighteenth-century-style rooms with high ceilings are decorated in golds and creams. **John Rutledge House Inn, Charleston**

This "quiet and relaxing" Georgian-style landmark has ironwork and Greek Revival porticos around the front door. Rooms have high ceilings. Tempurpedic beds, and Italian carved fireplaces. **Market Pavilion Hotel, Charleston**

This hotel one block from Charleston Harbor opened in 2002 but evokes the past with its 1880s design. Rooms are decorated with dark mahogany furniture, "lavish fabrics, decorative crown moldings on the ceiling," and oil paintings. **Wentworth Mansion, Charleston**

The former home of a cotton merchant has interiors with chandeliers and Tiffany glass panels. "Charming rooms" have gaslit fireplaces, king-size sleigh beds, and double walk-in showers. Watch the sunset from the rooftop cupola. Circa 1886 serves modern Southern cuisine in a restored carriage house. **Blackberry Farm, Walland**

"Attention to rustic details" is a hallmark of this Smoky Mountain retreat. Guests can choose art- and antiques-filled rooms with feather beds, or opt for a cottage with a fireplace and a porch. "Fantastic farm-fresh food" like Laurel Creek squab is served at The Barn. A creamery, bakery, and charcuterie are on the premises. **Lake Austin Spa Resort, Austin**

At this one-year-old Regency-style newcomer, guests find marble tubs and Bulgari bath amenities in perfect-scoring rooms, which also have city views "that you don't get tired of." Fearing's, named for "the incredibly outgoing" chef, serves up barbecued shrimp tacos under rawhide chandeliers. **Rosewood Crescent Hotel, Dallas**

The two-story entrance has limestone walls and marble floors and columns, and opens onto a garden terrace. **Rosewood Mansion on Turtle Creek, Dallas**

The food at this former private estate "was so good that we almost skipped Thanksgiving dinner at our aunt's—the foie gras melted in my mouth." Seasonal flowers bloom in manicured grounds, while indoors, cathedral doors and stained glass set the tone. Soon to be refurbished, rooms have views of the Dallas skyline and "super comfy beds with great linens."
